In math we have finished looking at 2D and 3D shapes, and have started looking at 3D shapes. Next week we will be looking at fractions and how 2D shapes can be divided into equal parts. We will also be looking at the area of a shape.

In Science we have continued to look at motion and how things move. This week we looked did a fun activity with levers. Students were able to make a few different types of lever and see how levers are able to help us with work. Next week we will be looking at magnets. We will be seeing how magnets work, and how they can attract and repel each other.

In social studies we have continued to work on our country project. The students have started researching their countries. So far we have researched the physical features, flag, and animals in the country. Students have also started to fill in their country posters. Next week we will finish filling in the posters and will start filling out the organizer for their 3-paragraph research paper.
